CALL TO WORSHIP - from Psalm 34

Leader: I will bless the LORD at all times; His praise shall continually be in my mouth. My soul makes its boast in the LORD; let the humble hear and be glad.

People: Oh, magnify the LORD with me, and let us exalt His name together!

Leader: I sought the LORD, and He answered me and delivered me from all my fears.

People: Those who look to Him are radiant, and their faces shall never be ashamed.

Leader: This poor man cried, and the LORD heard him and saved him out of all his troubles. The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear Him, and delivers them. Oh, taste and see that the LORD is good! Blessed is the man who takes refuge in him!

People: We fear the LORD, for we know that those who fear Him have no lack!

Leader: The young lions suffer want and hunger; but those who seek the LORD lack no good thing.

TABLE TALK

1. Describe the concept of “goodness.” What determines that someone or something is good?
2. How does goodness relate to the other “fruit of the Spirit” (Galatians 5:22-23)?
3. Consider the fact that “goodness” can be translated “generosity” in Galatians 5. How does this concept influence your understanding of goodness?
4. Read Hebrews 10:32-39. These people exhibit a “strange gospel generosity” in comparison to contemporary culture. Why do these Christians seem strange today? How would this passage read if it were describing strange Christians today? Be specific in your description.
5. Read 2 Corinthians 8:1-15. How do these verses encourage a “strange gospel generosity”?

CONFESSION - From James 1

Leader: Do not be deceived, beloved. Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change.

People: Of His own will He brought us forth by the word of truth, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of His creatures.

Leader: Know this beloved: let every person be quick to hear, slow to speak, slow to anger; for the anger of man does not produce the righteousness of God. Therefore put away all filthiness and rampant wickedness and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls.

People: Father, make us doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving ourselves.

Leader: For if anyone is a hearer of the word and not a doer, he is like a man who looks intently at his natural face in a mirror. For he looks at himself and goes away and at once forgets what he was like.

Now, let's proclaim God's promise to us:

All: But the one who looks into the perfect law, the law of liberty, and perseveres, being no hearer who forgets but a doer who acts, he will be blessed in his doing.

SERMON TEXT

Galatians 5:22-23

22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, **goodness**, faithfulness, 23 gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law.

Hebrews 10:32-36

32 But recall the former days when, after you were enlightened, you endured a hard struggle with sufferings, 33 sometimes being publicly exposed to reproach and affliction, and sometimes being partners with those so treated. 34 For you had compassion on those in prison, and you joyfully accepted the plundering of your property, since you knew that you yourselves had a better possession and an abiding one. 35 Therefore do not throw away your confidence, which has a great reward. 36 For you have need of endurance, so that when you have done the will of God you may receive what is promised.
