

Adult Education

The Book of Twelve (*Minor Prophets*)

Taught by Rob Alexander and Joey Jeffers - This class focuses on the twelve Old Testaments Prophets who you are probably vaguely familiar with but want to learn more about. Class will focus on one (or two) prophet(s) per week, cultural background and Biblical context, major themes of each book, and life application issues. Participants are encouraged to read one (or two) minor prophet(s) per week in parallel to lectures.

Financial Peace (*Runs Sept 12 – Dec 12*)

Taught by James Connolly - Do you struggle with managing finances? Do you find yourself in bondage to materialism and debt? Do you wonder what the Bible says about finances and the close connection of faith and management of God's resources? This video based class provides practical help to folks on all ends of the spectrum. The first hour of the class is spent watching a video, and a second hour is spent in follow up discussion and accountability. **Class meets in Library.**

Facilitated by Jennifer Sanders, Vern Schmidt, David Swayne - This class investigates foundational questions like "Who is God? Who is Man? Who is Jesus? Who is my guide?" The answers really matter, because they define who we are and why we are motivated to do what we do.

Class is designed to be an interactive learning environment intentionally mixed with fellowship and prayer (Much more like a fellowship group rather than a lecture.)

This is a good class for skeptics interested in the faith, new christians who desire a firm foundation, and anyone who wants to re-center their lives on God's Word.

Class materials include study "*Foundations: An Introduction to the Christian Life*" by David Sinclair.
