Why is she listening to this Jew?

Why was she picked?

Why did she allow the conversation to progress to the point of listening?

Why does she not want to come to the well anymore?

How did she know about the Messiah?

Answering the Interpretation ?s

- Looking for attitude change: confesses her desire for the water He talks about, a thirst recognized.
- Doesn't want to return to this place of shame.
- If Jesus can help her understand her physical thirst then He can speak to her spiritual thirst.
- The woman is drawn to Jesus. Jesus knows her fully and offers satisfaction.
